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BACK TO THE VEHICLE WHERE IT ALL BEGAN:

In the beginning, there was the sports car. This, at least, holds true for the creation of the legendary Chronograph I. The timepiece was designed in 1972 by Professor Ferdinand Alexander Porsche and featured a matte black dial, white hands and indices, and a red stopwatch second hand that were all inspired by the functional vehicle instruments inside the 911 and other Porsche racing cars. With his timeless and uncompromising design language, he revolutionised the status quo of the luxury watch industry at the time – because until then exclusive wristwatches were predominantly sparkling pieces of jewellery in silver and gold. With his puristic timepiece, Prof. F. A. Porsche took

a completely new, untródden path. The maxim “form follows function” derived from this has been at the core of the company’s philosophy since the very beginning – and the clean lines, strong contrasts continue to characterize every Porsche Design timepiece produced. Even now, almost 50 years later. Since then, wearing Porsche DNA on the wrist has been established as an exclusive experience. Time to come full circle: with the new Sport Chrono Collection and the Sport Chrono Package with Porsche Design Subsecond watch. Porsche Design has returned to where it all began – in the sports car itself. With pride of place in the middle of the dashboard.

SPORTS CARS AND WATCHES. INSEPARABLY LINKED.

As early as 1963, the Porsche 911 featured an electrically powered clock as part of the 5-tube instruments. In the early 2000s, Porsche enhanced the display by adding an additional central instrument in the middle of the dashboard. Initially, it enabled lap times to be displayed. It was continuously developed until, as part of the Sport Chrono Package, it was no longer a classic

three-hand watch, but an instrument with digital display and hands. The vision of combining an optimally legible timekeeping instrument with a sports car has now become reality with the new Sport Chrono Package with Porsche Design Subsecond watch, which is available in the Panamera, Taycan and 911.



UNMISTAKABLE PORSCHE DESIGN. IN THE VEHICLE AND ON YOUR WRIST.

Three dial colour options – black, blue or brown – and two different case sizes provide the perfect companion to the subsecond version on the dashboard of the vehicle. With its metal dial and running seconds at 6 o'clock, it not only impresses with its stylish, minimalist design, but with a high-quality and

highly durable titanium case. Thanks to a soft strap made of genuine Porsche vehicle leather, the various models are not only comfortable, but timelessly elegant on the wrist of the wearer – and thus form the perfect complement to the Sport Chrono Package of the vehicle.





SEVEN MODELS. ONE ICONIC STYLE.

In line with the tradition of the Chronograph I, the Sport Chrono Collection translates the timeless design of Porsche instruments into an exclusive timepiece: as subsecond timepieces in three different colour options or chronometers with chronograph function.

With the Subsecond timepiece, for the first time in the history of Porsche Design, a timepiece is being released in two different case sizes: the familiar 42 mm version, and a new 39mm version.
